Butch brought in his classic Doomsday Machine from Star Trek the Original series. @39" long and illuminated with a micro machines Enterprise out front to help depict scale.

Wes brought in a Pennsylvania Class USS Arizona showing how she would have looked if she had survived Pearl Harbor. The upgrades included extra "5 inch gun mounts along her beams. Wes also brought in a model of the USS Tarawa that he is doing a magnificent job on as a commission for a customer who's husband served on her during his time in the Navy. Greg took the time to add rivets to the build and mentioned how much he enjoyed his results with the exhaust stains. Also Greg had a Zvezda SU-57 in splinter camouflage for us to enjoy.
