John also took the original AMT Enterprise kit and turned it into a very cool kitbash of a Federation Battle Cruiser bearing the name USS Everhart. To round out his Star Trek representations there

was an Enterprise “B” on the table in 1/2500 scale and then moved on to the original Galactica and another Bandai kit with a Star Destroyer. Last but not least were two 4” aircraft carriers, the Enterprise and Kittyhawk. Nice collection of work!

Greg brought in a beautiful 1/72 Privateer from Matchbox for his entrant into the BB theme build. Greg put the build through lots of enhancements and upgrades scratchbuilding most of the cockpit and adding resin engines, props, and cowlings and home made gun belts.

Butch had his recently finished USS Mira, a 1/537 Enterprise refit kit from AMT with an Alliance Models Belknap resin conversion kit. Also on the table was an almost finished Tamiya Panther in 1/35 scale with aftermarket tracklinks and for Butch’s BB presentation the Doomsday Machine!

Chris Fowler, for his BB presentation had a 1/100000 scale Star Destroyer by Bandai beautifully painted and weathered.

Wes who showed up at the nick of time shared a nicely built 1/350 Typhoon submarine kit by Dragon which also came with Kilo class submarine as a bonus.
